No truth to the rumor we can't think that the Blazers want to join the MLS lockout, though it might not be a bad idea. Anything, perhaps, to prevent getting on the court, as it appears as if the Portland season effectively ended at the All Star break. If you recall, the Blazers had experienced a brief lull right after the trade deadline, winning and covering four in a row, when practically every key contributor save Damion Lillard (who's not playing anyway right now due to recent abdominal sore surgery) was cleaned up, and what emerged was able to ride the wagons around the likes of G. Aronaeo Simsone, who was greatly enjoying his new role in the spotlight. But there's still a distant memory since returning from the break with five double-digit losses in a row, and that hardly certifies the degree of the carnage with four of those losses by 30 points or more. Lone Portland bright soul Simsone didn't even play in the most-recent humiliation on Monday at Minnesota due to a quad injury, but not sure how much of difference he could make if the defense continues to get strafed, showing a whopping 127 pg during the recent slump, and not surprisingly the league's worst defense at a near-average 125 points per 100 possessions. The recent loss of C. Alonzo (foot) hasn't helped matters either. Losing for an 8th straight win (and each cover in sight) in Salt Lake City, the Jazz would seem to be heading to successive losses by default, though if there's a caution it's that Utah is listed to cover the last four on its just-completed road trip. But let's not over-complicate things; if we can't recommend against the Blazers at the moment, who can we recommend against?

To get back at the headline on the sports page of the Post after the Broncos lanced Russell Wilson, the Nuggets are going to have to do something extraordinary like win a game by 50 points, or Nikola Jokic to score the same. More than likely, we suspect the Nugs will just have to settle on being a secondary headline for a while, or until the Wilson buzz wears off, just a bit. Interestingly, this is still broncos Country, so we're not sure when that might happen. Whatever, those two have seen a lot of each other lately, meeting in back-to-backs right out of the All-Star break. Not surprisingly, the Nuggets won both, though it was the home game in Denver that turned out to be the real battle as the Kings managed a cover at Ball Arena after getting smoked by 10 at home. Sasha actually did a fairly decent job slowing Jokic, who "only" scored 21.5 pg across those two (not quite up to Jager standards), though he earlier hit the Kings for 33 in a 121-111 win on Jan. 7. Meanwhile the Kings are still clinging to the edge of the West Play-in "outlook" but blew a chance to get a favorite stretch of games (six of seven at Golden 1 Center) off to a good start when losing at home to the Knicks on Monday. Sasha is rapidly running out of time to make a move, but odds are that it won't happen as the restructure of the lineup at the trade deadline has only made a minimal impact. The Kings' punchee's chance comes with G. DeArmon Fox, who is on a rather incredible run at the moment of nine straight games hitting 50% or better from the floor, and recently putting 24 on Dallas. Sasha, however, will test that one. He's got guaranteed a 10th straight season with a record record, and would prefer not to trust these guys unless the spread inches a bit higher (the 4-4.5 on the over/under makes the Nuggets very interesting).

The Wizards are 5-5 SU in their last 10 games, not bad for a team that's been on the outside looking in of the playoffs since what turned out to be a mediocre 10-3 SU start to the season. The Wizards finally got 3 points at home against the Sacramento Kings. They're 3-1 in the last 5, 12-12 overall, and 10-10 SU. The Wizards are 12-12 SU in their last 25 games on the road. The Clippers who beat the Wizards 115-116 in first meeting, last, 25 at Capital One Arena when Luke Kennard scored 7 points in the final 5 seconds of the game. Washington was led by Bradley Beal's 23 pts. in that one, and he is through for the season, but Porzingis could have more success against the Clips. Last Sunday, The Wizards are 4-1-1 vs. the points in their last 6 and have been "over" 5-1 in that span (excl. 120 app and incl. 50% w/w in their 5 wins in those games). The Clippers lost their first 5 SU and opened the year in 2nd night of back-to-back games this season (4-2 see 3-0 SU and 4-1 against the Clippers since then). The Big Sky didn't disappoint again last weekend with the season-long "overs" holding to form, and would expect that trend to continue, at least in the early rounds, in the conference journey at 2020. Even Idaho State got on the stat as the regular season concluded, even if it in a loss (though it helped that recent 73-69 loss vs. Portland State on Feb. 26 required OT), with top scorer and all-time G. Hank Cool (who converted for 30 points) vs. Idaho getting a bit more scoring help from 6-5 USD transfer Julian Rodriguez, who has scored in double digits in six of his last seven games and passed Northern Colorado's 27 two weeks ago, and 6-8 FG Malli Pinter, who scored 18 in the season's final Northern Arizona game. And the other teams in the Big Sky? "Not" Portland State, who has played only one game since that unexpectedly losing and losing NAU since Jan. 22 that ended up with this over/under total of 13. As we've noted, there's a degree before that was when first-year HC Jason Colburn effectively took the reins off of his transfer-laden roster and simply instructed them to "die." The Vikings have scored better than 80 pts. since, with a variety of transfers coming in and five different leading scorers in February games, and recently getting big production from 6-10 former ASU transfer F Khalid Thomas (21 avg. last four). PSU is also "over" H-2 its last 13 and hasn't had a "below" one lower than this one across that entire span. We'll try to squeeze as much out of this extended Vikings "over" trend as long as they're still paying!

Hardly a vintage year for Jim Boeheim at Syracuse, especially the last two weeks when closing with four straight losses which became especially galling within the past week, as a potential upset at North Carolina slipped away in the final seconds and OT, then a nightmare ending vs. Miami that has caused Boeheim's friends to keep sharp objects away from the coach after the Orange drew a 10-point lead in the last two minutes to Jim Larangan's Canes. The last two efforts in particular could have been wins vs. quality foes, however, so this isn't a normal 4-game losing streak, and Boeheim teams have rallied in conference tournaments before. For what it's worth, there are some ACC sources who are also watching the 'Cuse shut down very closely in Brooklyn, with Boeheim indicating a successor plan is in place while also confirming that neither of his boys on the team (Buddy and Jimmy) will be back next season, fueling speculation that Boeheim might be planning a quiet exit, as some firmly believe Boeheim wants nothing to do with a season-long fiasco. Stay tuned. Florida State will obviously have something to say about these proceedings on Wednesday, and the Noles put together three straight wins to close the regular season, but they have lost five of their last six away from Tallahassee, as this Leonard Hamilton edition doesn't cover ground like the defensive perimeter the way some of his better Noles editions from the recent past have done. FSU did win at the Carrier Dome in mid-January but also had a 1-8 SU stretch late in the season, as Hamilton had season-long issues working several new faces into the mix, though Houston transfer G Caleb Mills was making more consistent contributions in the later stages of the season. Mills also hit 5 of 6 triples when the Noles won the first meeting, so Boeheim knows well of him, but FSU's way and the ball's well as it did in the first meeting (55%), either. But the 'Cuse has a bit better balance with four active DD scorers led by Buddy's 14.3 ppg, and Orange three-point shooting (32.5% vs. 29%) has been good enough at times to change the momentum. A repeat spate of "overs" each way (FSU 1 last seven, 'Cuse 6-1 last five and 7-1 last eleven) also makes us think these teams can clear the mid-140s hurdle at Barclays Center.
